CALL FOR ENTRIES

The Washington Aggregates & Concrete Association is pleased to formally recognize your professional accomplishments in the outstanding use of Ready Mix Concrete throughout Washington State.

Entries are juried by an independent panel of industry professionals comprised of 2016 award winners. Finalists and a category winner are selected from each of the categories. The Grand Award winner will be awarded to the category winner that best reflects the unique advantages of Ready Mix Concrete. In recognition of their contributions, our Concrete Awards will be presented to the Owner, Architect, Contractor, Structural Engineer, Concrete Contractor, and Ready Mix Supplier.

SUBMITTAL GUIDELINES

- Projects must be located in Washington State.
- Projects are eligible for 2 years after their completion (from January 2015 to December 2016).
- Projects must be classified in one of the following categories: Cast-In-Place Structures, Special Applications, Public Works, Tilt-Up,
 Concrete Paving, Pervious Concrete, Residential, Architectural Decorative Concrete, or Sustainable/Resilience Merit <u>OR</u> can be submitted in multiple categories as separate entries.
- Hybrid concrete elements such as modular, precast and cast in place are eligible. Entry should emphasize the unique role(s) of these concrete methods. Precast only projects are not eligible.
- Submit as many projects as you wish. Each entry should be in a separate binder (with the exception of online submittals).

RESILIENCE & SUSTAINABLE MERIT CATEGORY

This categories recognizes the role and contribution concrete has in both resilient and sustainable construction. Entries should summarize each as it applies to their project. In addition to meeting sustainable protocols; LEED 2009, LEED V4.0, EPD's or other criteria, concrete meeting resilient construction objectives in the built environment should be described.

Any project from any category is eligible and may also remain entered as an entry in multiple categories.

Projects entered in the Resilience & Sustainable Merit category should emphasize the direct contribution of concrete to meet project objectives and contributions to LEED credits, other rating systems, or resilient criteria. These include but are not limited to:

- LCA, EPD, or other sustainable criteria contributions
- Use of High Performance Wall systems and improved energy efficient outcomes
- Use of recycled materials in concrete products, recycled applications and to optimize mix designs
- Use of Pervious concrete for storm water management strategies and sustainable site development
- Other innovative concrete strategies for interior and exterior sustainability; healthy indoor environment, exposed finished surfaces, reduced maintenance, site enhancement, natural daylighting, energy efficiency etc.

- A Digital copy of your photos, and 1 Project Description all free of firm names & logos.

WITH EITHER FORMAT

- Concrete is a multi-dimensional building material, TELL YOUR CONCRETE STORY!
- All binders, photos & submitted info shall be retained by the WA Aggregates & Concrete Association for publicity use at our discretion.
- A one-page summary of your project describing the advantages of using ready mix concrete, such as durability sustainability, economy, constructability, lifecycle benefits, project aesthetics, compatibility with project environment, etc. must be written on plain, letterhead free, 8.5x11 stationary with project name only. Be descriptive. Projects are judged largely on the quality of this project description.
- A single project can be submitted in multiple categories. Treat each submittal individually to emphasize the unique elements for each category in both the narrative and photos.
- · Your photos should represent your projects in both finished and/or during construction phases and should be of high quality.


